

<b>Unit: Digital Photography with PhotoShop Elements</b>	
<b>Project: Digital Mandala</b>	<b>Level: 6, 7, 8 grade</b>
<b>Objectives:</b>	<b>Procedures:</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Student will use Photoshop to manipulate a photograph</li> <li>• Students will learn proper use of networks to save and manage files.</li> <li>• Students will learn to use Photoshop tools: Lasso tool, Move tool, copy and paste, layers and</li> </ul>	<p><b>Class time needed:</b> I spent 2-40 minute class periods on this project and 80% of the kids completed the project.</p> <p><b>BEFORE lesson:</b> Make sure to save a folder of copyright free images that the kids can access. Pick pictures that are bright in color and simple in pattern. Print out copies of the step-by-step directions. If working with MANY classes, print one class set and put in plastic page protectors for repeated use.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Share with students the meaning of Mandala.</li> <li>2. Show images of a variety of art Mandalas.</li> <li>3. On a projector demonstrate the entire process, have the students follow along with the handout.</li> <li>4. Clearly describe the necessary steps for finding and saving files on your particular network with the "Browse for Files" feature in PhotoShop. If necessary create a handout or write on the board for kids to reference.</li> <li>5. Have kids use the handout to work on their own to create and save at least one Mandala.</li> </ol>
