HOMEWORK:

Students automatically have homework when they have not finished the project IN CLASS during studio time. Each project will have 2-7 days of in class work time to complete it, depending on the project.

SUMMATIVE:

Summative projects are indicated by (S) on the calendar. They are 70% of the grade and are graded on the student's ability to DEMONSTRATE the learned ART SKILL, TECHNIQUE or BEHAVIOR.

FORMATIVE:

Formative projects are indicated by (F) on the calendar. They are 30% of the grade and are graded on completeness, effort and participation.

CENTERS:

Centers are "media" based. They are a location in the classroom that has ALL the supplies needed for a particular type of artwork. They will be opened one at a time and students can use them IF they have completed the INTRO assignment.
